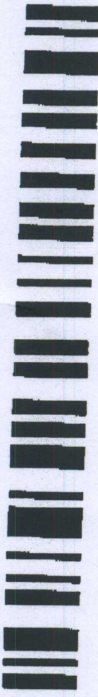

Police Officer Carlos Percz, shield 27093 of the 013 Precinct, states as follows:

On September 22, 2009, at about 09:37 hours on the corner of East River and 20th Street in the County and State of New York, the Defendant committed the offenses of:


- 1. PL140.05 Trespass
(1 count)

the defendant knowingly entered and remained unlawfully in and upon premises.

The offenses were committed under the following circumstances:

Deponent states that the deponent observed the defendant inside of a fenced area located at the above named location that is surrounded by a metal fence on three sides and the East River on the fourth side. Deponent states that a conspicuously posted sign is positioned on the above described fence, which states "No Sitting, No Climbing" and that the deponent observed the defendant climb the above described fence to enter the fenced in area. Deponent further states that the deponent is a custodian of the above described area and that the defendant did not have permission or authority to enter, remain, or be inside of the above described fenced in area.

False statements made herein are punishable as a class A misdemeanor pursuant to section 210.45 of the penal law.
